

# Traffic disruption due to renovation of A29 in 2024

## What and why?

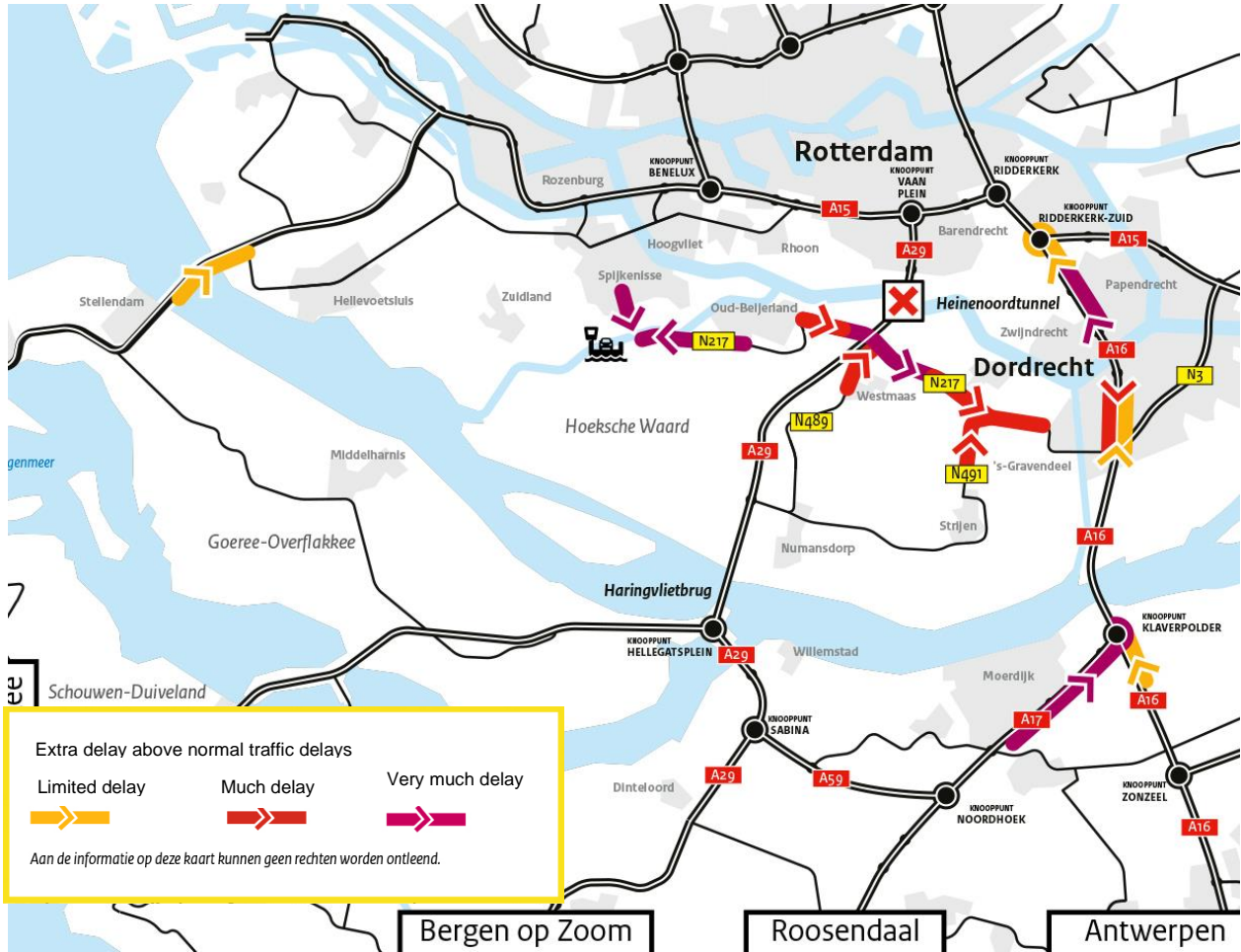
The Heinenoord Tunnel, located on the A29 highway, was built in the 1960's and is in **need of major renovation**. In order to ensure safe performance of the renovation work, the A29 highway was closed multiple times in 2023 and will also be **closed a couple of times in 2024**. Traffic will be diverted via highways A16 and A17, so please keep in mind that those diversion routes will be very busy.

## Expected delay

- Very busy during peak hours.
- Very busy on highways **A16 and A17**.
- The delay can be up to an hour.

## Advice to road users:

- **Work from home** if possible.
- If you live close to work, **consider traveling by bike**.
- Check with you manager if it is possible to start your **workday a bit earlier or later**.
- Consider **carpooling** with a colleague
- Be well prepared before departing and be aware of the planning and diversion routes.



## Planning

In addition to several long-term closures (see below) the A29 highway will be (partly) closed during various nights as well. Click [here](#) for the complete planning of 2024

- July 26<sup>th</sup> till August 9<sup>th</sup>** - Closed to all traffic (in both ways)
- Augustus 30<sup>th</sup> till September 2<sup>nd</sup>** - Closed in the direction of Rotterdam
- September 13<sup>th</sup> till September 16<sup>th</sup>** - Closed to all traffic (in both ways)
- September 20<sup>th</sup> till September 23<sup>th</sup>** - Closed in the direction of Bergen op Zoom
